- **Theme:** Adventure
- **Original Artwork:** One piece per artist or team. Team members may not also enter as individuals.
- **Artwork:** Limited to pieces that can be hung on the gallery wall.
- **Media:** Photography (digital or traditional); Painting (acrylic or watercolor); Drawing (pen & ink, pencil, or pastels); or Mixed Media (any combination of techniques)
- **Format:** Art must be framed and/or matted with an acceptable hanging system. For complete submission guidelines, size restrictions, and examples of acceptable hanging systems, please see the library's website. Artwork with inadequate hanging systems will not be accepted.
- **Entry Forms:** Available at the Teen Space on library.livermoreca.gov.
- **Entries:** Submit artwork in person at the Civic Center Library's Information Desk. Entries are accepted for artists in grades 6 through 12 who live in or attend school in Livermore.
- **Submission Period:** 12 p.m., Sunday, March 1 through 4 p.m. on Sunday, March 22, 2026.
- **Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for both middle school and high school age groups.
- **Art Reception:** Thursday, April 13, 2026, at 7 p.m. in the Civic Center Library, Community Rooms. Drawing: Prizes will be given to randomly selected artists in attendance at the art reception.
- **Reclaim Artwork:** Artwork will be available for pickup starting Saturday, May 2, 2026. The library will keep the artwork no later than Saturday, May 23, 2026.

Submit by March 22, 2026, with Label, Receipt, and Entry Form (below). Artists: Please keep the receipt to reclaim your artwork. If someone else picks up your work, they will need the receipt. You may also use a valid ID or library card. The label below will be placed on your work for identification. By entering the item, the artist grants permission for it to be photographed and/or be publicized. **Questions: 925-373-5505**
